Medium Rated Priorities (3.00-3.99)

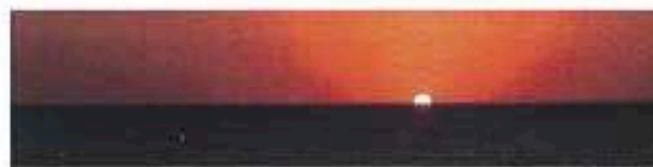
- Preparation for Catastrophic Storms (3.63)

- Offshore Wind Farm Development (3.50)
- Decreasing Commercial Properties (3.42)
- Water/Sewer Charges (3.05)
- First Responder Supporter (3.00)

Lower Rated Priorities (0-2.99)

- Municipal Voting Rights for Non-Resident Taxpayers (2.98)
- Bicycle/Pedestrian Safety (2.84)
- Bayside Bulkhead Requirements (2.44)
- Neighborhood Watch/Safety (2.18)

This valuable input will be used to guide our strategic plans for 2022 and beyond.
